- Item 4th I do hereby nominate and appoint my friend and
Stepson James King of the City of Savannah Executor
to this my last will and testament. In witness where-

sixth day of January eighteen hundred and fifteen.

In the name of God Amos: I Charles Stewart of the District of White Bluff in the County of Chatham and State of Georgia Planter, being sick and weak of body but of sound mind memory and understanding and considering the certainty of death and the uncertainty of the time thereof; and to the end that I may be the better prepared to leave this world when it shall please Almighty God to call me hence Do therefore make and declare this to be my last will and testament hereby revoking and annulling all former wills by me at any time heretofore made.

As to such worldly estate where with it hath pleased God to entrust me I dispose thereof in the following manner; that is to say; It is my will in the first place that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my decease as conveniently may be: and I desire by gift lease devise and bequest unto Robert Halesham of the City of Savannah merchant Robert Houston and William Davies of the same place

and to the survivors and survivor of them and to the heirs executors administrators and assigns of such survivor all that tract of Land or Plantation whereon I now reside called Belvoir situate lying and being on Vernon River in the aforesaid County of Chatham supposed to contain one hundred and fifty seven acres with all and singular the Buildings Houses edifices improvements rights members and appurtenances thereon and thereto appertaining and belonging and all those two Islands of Land called and known by the names of ~~Two Islands~~ and Racoon Islands situate lying and being in the County of Bryan in the State of Georgia aforesaid together with all and singular the rights members ^{with the same belonging and appurtenances} and appurtenances
