my last will and testament in manner and form following that to
wit First and principally I bequeath my precious and im-
mortal Soul to Almighty God, who gave it me, Hoping his precious
acceptance thereof through the merits of my Lord and Saviour Jesus
Christ, and my body I bequeath to the earth to be decently interred
at the discretion of my Executors William A Grant and George
H. H. H.

Now I give and bequeath the proceeds of a Lot or half Lot
on Leobonum Square, Savannah, Ga. to the Bank of Georgia
to dispose of to pay my first debt with thirty four hundred in the
Bank of Georgia

Now I give one hundred Dollars a piece to Emeline & Luquand-
Grant daughters of William A Grant and Mary Grant, the residue
after my debt is paid to be divide equally between William Gale
Eliza Gale and Hotty Gale The plate and furniture to be exclusively
to Hotty Gale. In Witness hereof I set my hand and seal at this
City New York
October 1824.
