my make this my last will and Testament in the
manner and form following to wit

I do declare that A & S Scudides are indebted
to me in the sum of two hundred and three Dollars
& 50 cents up to the 5th of August last past according
to settlement and also six weeks wages at nine Dollars
per week making the sum of fifty four Dollars
upon which the sum of twelve Dollars & twenty five
cents hath been paid to me Account of said wages
Patrick Hoyt is also indebted to me in the sum of
twenty five Dollars & thirty seven cents

I give devise and bequeath unto
my father the sum of One hundred Dollars to be sent
to him by my Executor when the above debts shall be
paid and in case that my said Father be dead
then & in that case I give and bequeath unto my Brother
Daniel Harrison the said sum of one hundred
Dollars and in case of the death of my said Brother
Daniel before receiving said sum then & in that case
the said sum of one hundred Dollars shall be de-
vied by my other Brothers share & share alike

I give devise and bequeath unto my
beloved wife Ann Harrison all the rest and residue
due of my Estate of what nature stand subject to
disposal of the same as her own property for ever

I do hereby nominate & appoint my
said Wife Ann Harrison sole Executrix of this my
last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other
testaments & codicils by me heretofore made declar-
ing this to be my last will and Testament I do
declare that Patrick McGowan is indebted to me
in the sum of Seventeen Dollars which I request
him to pay to Richard Harrison to be sent by
him to my Father

day of October in the year of Our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and twenty
