my property, and that she is to have the full enjoyment
and free disposal of all my estate - and if it should so
result that both my children and my wife die and leave
no bodily issues then and in that case the property which
comes to me from my uncle Josiah's Estate to go back to the
heirs of that estate namely to Sarah Lafil and Daniel

children dying and leaving no bodily issues then
