Chatham Co. Will Book H 1817-1827

Chatham County 3 Chambers of the Court of Ordinary
September 9th 1820

Present the Honourable Thomas N. Moul & George
Luns Cape Justices of the Superior Court of Chatham
County having Ordinary Jurisdiction

Personally came and appeared Ambrose Hall of Savan-
nah a subscribing witness to the foregoing will of George
Kingston late of Savannah Carpenter deceased who
being duly sworn doth declare and say that he was
present and did see the said George Kingston deceased
sign and seal and heard him pronounce publish and
declare the foregoing instrument as and for his last
will and testament that the said George Kingston
deceased was at the time of executing the same of
sound and disposing mind and memory to the best
of this deponents knowledge and belief that he the
deponent and William Locke and Thomas Muir and
Jiffrey O'Connell subscribed their names as witnesses to
the last execution of the said will at the request of
the testator in his presence and in the presence of each
other
