Present the Honourable Oliver Sturges & Thomas A Morel Justices of the Inferior Court of Chatham County having Ordinary Jurisdiction Personally appeared John O Connell - a Subscribing witness to the annexed last Will and Testament of Michael Leahy late of Savannah deceased who being duly sworn doth declare and say that he was present and did see the said Michael Leahy deceased sign & seal and then pronounce publish and declare the said annexed instrument of writing to be and contain his last will & Testament That the said Michael Leahy deceased was at the time of executing the same of sound and disposing mind and memory to the best of this deponent's knowledge & belief That he the deponent and John O Connell & Ann Mc Laughlin subscribed their names as witnesses to the due execution of the said will at the request of the Testator in his presence of each other
