ward I gave the sum of four hundred and fifty
Dollars annually for four years next succeeding my
decease to be paid to him out of the proceeds of my Es-
tate the testimony of which I have hereunto set my
hand and seal at the City of Savannah aforesaid the
twelfth day of September eighteen hundred and twenty
Signed sealed published and declared by the Test
as at and for a bequest to his last will and testament
in the presence of us who in the presence of each other
have subscribed our names as witnesses to the
same

him sign seal and heard him pronounce
publish and declare the second of said in-
strument of writing to be and contain a Codicil
to the said last will and testament to be taken
and received with and as part thereof - That
the said Thomas E. Lloyd was at the time of
executing the said will and codicil of sound
and disposing mind and memory to the best of
the deponent's knowledge and belief That he
this deponent and Thomas Bourke and Abraham
Nicholls subscribed their names as witnesses to
the said Will in the presence of the testator at
his request and in the presence of each other

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that Thomas H. O'Connell and the said Abraham
Nicholls together with the Defendant subscribed their
names as witnesses to the due execution of the said Con-
sent at the request of the said Thomas H. Lloyd in the
presence and in the presence of each other
