funeral expenses and all my lawful debts liquidated by my
executors here for me. 3^d That all annuities and other
debts be collected together with my other assets belonging to me
at my death and be distributed by my executors during a pa-
riod mentioned in the following manner. First to my Grandmother
Sarah Jacob Loby \$100 and legenath the sum of 179
dollars lawful money of the United States. 2^d To my son and
13th for his faithful services to me I give and bequeath
the sum of twenty dollars. The residue to be divided into
ten equal shares between the Children of Christian D and
Mary Loby and of Chas C Catherine Hiner. The part
pertaining to the later in trust to my executors herein mentioned
and S. Hasty I hereby nominate and appoint Robert H
Tolliver Esq and Christian D Loby Executors of this my
last Will and Testament.

In testimony thereof I have countersigned
affixed my hand and seal done at Daufuskie Island
the twenty-fourth day of March in the year of our Lord
eighteen hundred and seventy three and the forty seventh
of American Independence.
