County of Chatham, Esquires, and to their heirs, ex-
ecutors Administrators and assigns forever, In trust
nevertheless, to and for the use of my Brother John McClarain
my Nephew David McClarain and Niece Mary McClarain
in the following proportions to wit. One third part thereof
to my Brother John McClarain one third part to my
Nephew David McClarain and the remaining third part
to my Niece Mary McClarain and to their heirs, ex-
ecutors administrators and assigns forever, and to be conveyed
sold and disposed of in such manner and at such times
as they the said John, David and Mary McClarain
shall directly limit and appoint, and to and for no
other use intent or purpose, in witness whereof
