 all men once to die. Do make this my last will
 and testament in form and effect as follows

Item 1st I have also devised to my dear
 beloved wife two trunks of wearing apparel
 with the contents of the said trunks be they
 what they may.

Item 2nd I have & devise to my
 dearly beloved wife the sum of Eighty five
 dollars & thirty nine cents which appears to be
 due from Frederick Malt to me for work
 done and I also give the sum of eight dollars
 and seventy five cents due me for work done
 here to my said wife.

Item 3rd I have devise and bequeath
 unto my dearly beloved wife all the property within
 consisting in lands or negroes which I now own and
 all my claims or title to any property whatever which
 I might have become possessed of particularly to all
 such lands and negroes of which I would have an
 equal share (after the death of my mother) in conjunc-
 tion with my brother.

Item 4th And for the due execution
 of this my last will and testament I hereby appoint
 my dearly beloved wife my executrix and also ear-
 nestly request Mrs Isaac Plym to act in conjunction
 with her as executrix in such a manner that
 the ends of justice may be fully accomplished.
 In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and seal this twenty third day of September one
 thousand eight hundred and twenty
