In the name of God, amen. I, Sam-
uel Baas of Effingham County, in the State of Georgia
being in perfect health and of sound mind may-
ing & understanding blessed be god for the same, do
make publish and declare this to be my last will
& testament in manner and form following to wit
Inasmuch I desire and direct, that all my just
debts

Funeral expenses be paid & discharged as soon as possible
 after my decease by my executor herein after named. Also
 I give devise & bequeath unto my beloved wife Rebecca all
 that tract of land lying & being on the Louisville road where
 we now reside, together with all the hereditaments thereunto
 belonging, during her natural life & after her decease then
 my executor herein after named is requested to dispose of
 the said land & hereditaments thereunto belonging to the best
 advantage & the neat proceeds of the same to be equally
 divided amongst my three daughters named Ann, Rosanna
 & Serena Sarah, also I give & bequeath unto my beloved
 wife two negroes named Tom & Nancy during her natu-
 ral life. To have the labour & service of said two negroes
 during her natural life. also I give and bequeath unto my
 beloved wife all my stock of cattle, horses, hogs, household
 furniture and all other personal & moveable property of
 what kind soever & wheresoever the same may be to have
 the use of the said property during her natural life, with-
 out impeachment of waste, except it be such cases as
 the children has chose out of the stock by their mother's desire
 They are their own and their increase from the time they made
 their choice and after the decease of my beloved wife, the
 said personal property of every kind soever whatsoever
 it may be, my executor herein after named is requested to
 dispose of the same to the best advantage & the neat
 proceeds thereof to be divided amongst my four children
 named. Daniel Alexander, Ann, Rosanna & Serena Sa-
 rah, also I devise & bequeath unto my son Daniel Alexan-
 der his heirs and assigns for ever immediately after my de-
 cease all that tract of land lying & being in Bryan County
 on old Mill Creek, with the hereditaments thereunto belonging
 Also I request my executor herein after named when he divide
 the neat proceeds of the personal property amongst
 my four children above named, that he do reserve as
 much out of the said proceeds as will pay six months
 Schooling more. for Serena Sarah, and her clothing
 board and washing until she arrives to the age of eight
 years or marries, so that her part of the joint stock
 may be equal with the other children, exclusive of the
 said expences, as I think it most proper is that she
 do & I do appoint my executor herein after named to be
 guardian of my daughter Serena Sarah until she is
 old enough to choose one for her self. and I do also
 appoint my executor herein after named to see after and to
 have the last and improvements theron in charleston the
 was left to me and my heirs by my uncle Thomas Butler

according to his will. as copy is left in my hands to see up
for it I have it sold to the best advantage & the net
proceeds of the said lot improvements after the expenses
attending the same are paid by my executors. Then the
remainder & residue of the same to be equally divided
amongst my children as the will directs and I do con-
stitute and appoint Zara Powers Esq^r Executor of this
my last will & testament & trustee for my beloved wife &
children. in witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this 29th Day of June in the year of
our Lord one thousand eight hundred & fourteen &
in the thirty eighth year of the independence of the
United States of America.
