of Georgia being now in a sane and perfect sound
state of mind do hereby and make and declare this
my last Will and Testament annulling all former
last Impressed Twenty year and hereafter with my
son Daniel Sanders for both during his natural life
only the use and benefit arising from the one third
part of all and every species of property I am possessed
of at the time of my decease the survivor and
household stuff the third part of which I desire my
Executors to give up to said Daniel Sanders soon
after my death to do as he pleases with
It is my Will I give and hereafter also to my daughter
Margaret Muller and to my grandson Francis C. Muller
son of the above named Margaret the remaining
two thirds of all and any property movable real bond
and blamless whatsoever I may be possessed of to be
divided equally between them. My daughter Margaret
acts part to be put into her possession and disposal
as soon after my decease as it can be conveniently
done. My obligations on their part to be paid
half yearly that is one sixth part every six months
to all parents or legal guardian for the use and
benefit of said Francis C. Muller during his
minority And in case of either or both dying before
the said property is consumed unless they it shall
revert to their Heirs assigns and representatives
But in regard to my son Daniel's third
part (the household stuff excepted) I hereby en-
join and put it into charge & trust of the selling
& executors of this my last Will for the better and
safe keeping & application of the same to his use
whenever in cases of sickness or accident and
casualties of misfortune. But on no pretence whatever
shall the said Daniel Sanders have the handling
& disposal of the same at his own discretion and
should there remain any thing from his third part
at his death Then the same shall revert to my da-
ughter Margaret or her representatives or assigns
I do hereby nominally appoint request the follow-
ing persons or either of them to be and act as
Executors or Executors of this my last Will &
Testament viz. Mr. Chas. Sanders & Mr. Lewis
& wife of Savannah
Done at Savannah this twenty
eighth day of August in the year of our Lord

I Christians Young of the City of Savan-
nah being at present weak in body but of sound
and perfect mind and memory do make this
my last will and Testament in manner and form
following

First I desire after my decease my three negro
by name Adam Thabo and Mary be sold they
being allowed to choose their owners at the price
that persons of Judgement may fix as the value
of them and the money arising from the sale of
the said three negroes after paying my just debts
I give and bequeath to my beloved nephew Doct^r
James Perry of South Carolina I also give and
bequeath to my beloved niece Jane Dunwoody
Wife of John Dunwoody Esq a Negro Woman
named Belle and her issue for which she has in
her possession a deed of Gift I also give and bequeath
to my Dear Nephew James S Bulloch a
Negro Boy named Cleazer for which he has a
deed of Gift I give my negro boy George to my
Dear William G. Bulloch, Son of John S Bulloch
which Negro Frank is to be given him when he
arrives but the age of eighteen years, untill that
time my Nephew James S Bulloch is to keep the
said Negro Frank in his possession allowing him
sum of Twelve dollars per Month which he is to put
in the Bank for the benefit of the said William
G. Bulloch, Son of John S Bulloch should James
S Bulloch wish after the term of years mentioned
to keep the Negro Frank he must get for William
G. Bulloch another equal in value

After my decease I give my good negro man
Casar his freedom and I hope the person of my
kindred will neglect him but take care of him
in remembrance of me for he well deserves it

And I do hereby appoint my Nephew James S
Bulloch my sole Executor of this my last will and
Testament I hereby render
