I, I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Bond and to his heirs for ever and not liable for his debts the following named negro slaves Charles and Oliver with the future issue of the female also free sons and slaves.

I, I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Elizabeth Bond and to her heirs for ever and not liable for her debts the following named negro slaves with the future issue of the female Lucy, Peter, Elizabeth & Mary Elizabeth were given to my said daughter Mary Elizabeth by my deceased father-in-law but I have had to pay John and Elizabeth for her since the death of the said son and father-in-law.

I, I give and bequeath to my son Nathaniel Bond and to his heirs for ever and not liable for his debts the following named negro slaves with the future issue of the female Abby in consideration of his fidelity to me, George Robertson, and in case of his death without children then to the sister of the said Nathaniel Bond.

I, I give and bequeath to my son James August Bond and to his heirs for ever and not liable for his debts the following named negro slaves with the future issue of the female Old Sam, Little Sam, and Mandy and in case of his death without children then to the sister of the said James August Bond.

I, I give and bequeath to my daughter Anne Jane Bond and to her heirs for ever and not liable for her debts or to be sold the following named negro slaves with the future issue of the female Light, David, John, Peter, and Little Hannah, this Hannah was given to my daughter Sarah Roberts but as I have had to pay John & Elizabeth for her but I have a right to give and bequeath her as I think proper and a binding one paper that were made some years ago respecting her, my Carpenter Bond now with all Thomas Bond to pay my house and I give and bequeath to my said daughter Anne Jane

some condition and on line of her Bond James and I have spent belonging to her.

I, I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Bond and to his heirs for ever and not to be sold or liable for his debts the following named negro slaves with the issue of the female Alfred, Big Hannah & Daniel and on rest of his death with one million then to the sister of the said Thomas Bond.

I, I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Bond and to her heirs for ever and not to be sold or liable for her debts the following named negro slaves with the issue of the female Margaret, Peter, Elizabeth daughter of Mary, and Mary daughter of Elizabeth.

I, I give and bequeath to my daughter Catherine Withers Bond and to her heirs for ever and not to be sold or liable for her debts the following named negro slaves with the future issue of the female Hannah & Rachel and her three children Charlotte, William & Susan (children).

I, I give and bequeath to my two daughters Sarah & Elizabeth Withers Bond and to their heirs for ever and not to be sold or liable for their debts and to all for their joint use and benefit a negro slave named Henry with her future issue.

I, I give and bequeath to my son James August Bond and to his heirs for ever and not to be sold or liable for his debts the said negro slave named Mary with their future issue however I deem it proper and so hereby give and bequeath to my said daughter Catherine Withers Bond and to her heirs for ever and not to be sold or liable for their debts the said negro slave named first and his three children for Henry & John with the future issue and increase of the female.

I, I give and bequeath to my said daughter Sarah Withers Bond and to her heirs for ever and not to be sold or liable for her debts the said negro slave named David and her two children with the future issue of the female.

I, I give and bequeath to my said two daughters Sarah & Elizabeth Withers Bond and to their heirs for ever and not to be sold or liable for their debts and to all for their joint use and benefit a negro slave named Charles and I do hereby decree and require that the said slave named Charles be bound unto them the said Sarah & Elizabeth.

15th I give and bequeath my plantation house
situated in Bryan County to all my children to be divided
into nine equal parts so that each may have a share
therein. There is the part they share of they wish I wish
they may choose to use one to each other.

16th The tract of land in Bryan County known by
the name of the tract I give and bequeath to my natural
and adopted children for their joint use and benefit together with
an other tract I may be entitled to from my father's estate
and also a lot of land in banking between the stream of
the said river by the number 133 said.

17th I give and bequeath my stock of all kinds
after taking care of the two cows and calves for Thomas
and one a three year old heifer to Sarah Ann White
sister to my first daughter. I give also Cornish
and Standard and a set of harness when taking her
share. I give the stock of my natural and adopted
first children and to be sold with my other household
furniture of every kind and description with my share
of it I give and bequeath to my four daughters for their
joint use and benefit.

18th My Black I desire to be divided among my
children.

19th In consideration of Rachel being under restraint
to two of my children it is my will that she reside in
her place where she may choose, not subject to the control
of any person and no wages or services to be required
of her and in case of becoming infirm or unable to
support herself I require and charge my four eldest
sons to maintain her and I desire two dollars per
month to be paid her during her life out of her
daughter Hannah's wages.

20th In consideration of Betty being the body and
soul of my father and now advanced in years it is
my desire that no wages or services be required of him
and in case of inability from infirmity or otherwise
to support himself I charge and require my four eldest
sons to administer to his wants and necessities.

21st In consideration of Rebecca being to me
in her life of almost it is my will that she
and pay wages as she has done for some years
Rachel is of age to take charge of her.

22d Elizabeth takes my note for four hundred dollars
for four Black slaves which Thomas & David had belonging
to her which note he must take up as it was given for her
benefit so that no part of my property may be taken for it.

23d It is my wish that the savings of the house in
all my possession be sold and that the proceeds of the sale
thereof be appropriated to the payment of my note in full
for \$100. I desire then to be authorized to give my note to
Stephen Williams for \$100 and my note to be paid for
\$100.00. I desire that no money be paid to the payment of
any other debts until I may order. I desire that my
note which I desire my executor to discharge from
the proceeds of my sale before. I also desire my executor
to keep duty at much credit from the proceeds of his sale
all my debts are paid which are my debts and that
he in no wise be given up to Elizabeth's profit they are
all paid.

24th I appoint Patrick Henslow, by the name
of this my last will and testament.

In witness whereof I have done the said De-
claration have signed and my hand and seal the being
first day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and twenty second.
