place or elsewhere to be equally divided between them and the
survivors of them share and share alike and their heirs for
ever. — Secondly. I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Catherine Ann Nichols two glass pictures all the silver plate
beds, bedding carpets and china ware that I may see posses-
sed of to be delivered by my executors herein after named and
immediately after my decease to Mrs. Maria Pierce, and Mrs. Eliza
Osborne to join with any other small articles which they
may deem necessary for the comfort of my said daughter
to be by them used or disposed of as they may think proper
Thirdly. All the residue of my personal Estate consisting
of three negroes my Clock, Jewelry and Jewels or any Bank
notes or cash on hand debts due or any other species of
property and not herein before disposed of I give & bequeath
unto my three children before named and the survivors
of them share and share alike and their heirs for ever
Lastly I do hereby request that my last will and testa-
