In the name of God amen I Edward Delagal of the State and County above named planters being of perfect memory, calling to mind the mortality of my body, knowing that it is appointed unto all men to die do make and ordain this my last will and testament that is to say principally and first of all I recommend my soul unto the hands of Almighty God who gave it and my body to be buried in a decent christian burial under the direction of my servants and executors. And as touching such worldly estate as it hath been pleased God to give unto me I give devise and dispose of in the following - after discharging my funeral charges and paying my just debts I bequeath unto my loving wife Sarah and my four children Emilye H. Edward Wentworth, Thomas Philip & Henry Barclay all my property both real and personal to be equally divided amongst them and do appoint Mrs. Jane Delagal my executrix. Thomas Delagal and Thomas King executors to this my last will and testament. Signed sealed the day of June 23^d 1819.
