

I Elizabeth Wood of the City of Savannah & State of Georgia, but resident in Middleburg in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts Merchant, being in a very infirm state of Health and sensible of my liability to a sudden Death at the same time being in my own apprehension of sound mind & memory, do judge it best to make & accordingly do hereby make this my last Will & Testament

It is my Will that all my just debts and The Charges of my funeral be paid & discharged by my Executor hereafter named & appointed out of my Estate as soon as conveniently may be after my decease, And I leave the Charges of my funeral to the discretion to my said Executor.

I give, devise, and dispose of all my Estate real and personal (save what may be necessary for the payment of my just debts & funeral Charges in the following manner,

I give to my beloved Wife Susan Wood the use and income of my dwelling House and Store in the City of Savannah and my negro slave Robert so long as she remains my widow upon Conditions however that my said Wife is to keep the said House & Store in good repair pay all duties and taxes that may be laid thereon and keep the same insured constantly for seven to five per cent on their estimated value at her own expense during her said widowhood and in case of her intermarriage I give her in lieu thereof the annuity & sum yearly of two hundred dollars to be paid to her out of my Estate for her exclusive use & benefit. The first annuity to be due and payable in one year after her intermarriage as aforesaid. I also give and bequeath to my said Wife all my household furniture and my two negro slaves Nancy and Julia and two hundred and fifty dollars in money to be hers forever. The said sum of two hundred and fifty dollars to be paid to her within twelve months after my decease.

Item I give and bequeath to Susannah Wilson the
 Writen of my wife one hundred dollars to be paid
 to her by Executor in one Year after my decease.
 Item I give to my son Charles Augustus Wood my
 Gold Watch.

Item The residue and remainder of all my Estate
 both real and personal (not herein otherwise
 disposed of) I give and grant to my Children
 that may be living or of which my said Wife
 may be seint at the time of my decease
 to be divided among them in the following share
 and proportions to wit: The Sons to have four
 dollars to the daughters three and so to their
 respective heirs forever.

I hereby appoint and constitute William
 Hall of Savannah aforesaid my sole Executor
 of this my last will and Testament

In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand & seal this ninth day of October
 in the year of our Lord one Thousand
 eight hundred and thirty two and publish
 and declare this to be my last Will &
 Testament.
