

I, Harriet T. Brown, of the City of Savannah in the County of Chatham widow, do make public and declare this my last Will and Testament.

I give devise and bequeath to my Executors and Executors hereafter named the following property to wit, all my right title and interest in the Southern Stock of Little River here twenty nine and thirty in Columbia Ward in Savannah together with all the improvements thereon and also the following negroes namely, Flora, Adam, Rebecca, Emily, Georgeanna, Sam Florence, Robert, Eliza & Charles to hold to them & the survivor of them his or her executors administrators and assigns in trust to pay and apply in such manner and form as they or the survivor of them shall deem most suitable from the proceeds rents issues and profits thereof one hundred and fifty dollars yearly for the use of my Brother Houston Houston Lunatic in the Asylum at Philadelphia in the State of Pennsylvania during his natural life; the remainder of the profits to be paid to my niece Eliza Houston Mary Houston and at the death of my Brother then in trust to convey the said property and the increase thereof to my said Nieces absolutely their heirs and assigns.

It is my order that Belinda, Peggy, Calo's and Scipio shall be sold by my Executors for the payment of my just debts should there be any; and if there should be a surplus after the payment of all my just debts, I give and bequeath such surplus to my Nieces the said Eliza Houston and Mary Houston, but should I have no debts to be paid, then I give and bequeath the said and negroes to wit, Belinda, Peggy, Calo's and Scipio with the fixtures issue of the female slaves to my said Nieces to hold to them forever.

I give and bequeath unto my Nieces the said Eliza and Mary all my House hold Furniture.

I do nominate constitute and appoint Jonathan Thomas of McIntosh County and Mary A. Thomas his Wife Executors and Executrix of this my last Will and Testament.

In Witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name & affixed my seal this eighth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty three.
