

Georgia City of Savannah

In the name of God Amen!

I Jacob Delamater of the City of Savannah aforesaid, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs, do let, I shew especially to dole do unto and publish this my last will, and testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me made.

First I give devise and bequeath unto my son Jacob Delamater Jr. of the City of Savannah aforesaid, attorney at law and my right title and interest of in and to the certain half of that lot or piece of land situate lying and being in the City of Savannah, near Pelham Square known in the plan of the said City of Savannah by the Number (143) fifteen back on which and bounded south by Miller Street, together with the houses edifices and buildings thereon situate, and all other the right members and appurtenances thereto in anywise in anywise or appertaining to have and to hold unto him his heirs &c. I do devise &c. I do bequeath &c. his heirs &c. administrators and assigns forever to and for him and their only heirs and assigns.

Secondly I do give and bequeath and my will is that my debts funeral expenses, and the costs & charges of the probate of this my last will and testament, be paid out of the wages and proceeds of the hire and labour of my slaves, and after the payment thereof then I give and bequeath as follows

Thirdly I give and bequeath Jacob Delamater after such payment as aforesaid unto my said son Jacob Delamater Junior his executors and administrators my negro girl named Leah to have and to hold unto him the said Jacob his executors & administrators in trust and to use for the use benefit and behoof of my grand child Leonard Eliza the daughter of David & Mary Eliza until she shall arrive at the age of twenty one years or be married or her marriage be solemnized at the age of twenty one years to the said Leonard Eliza her
