

James B. Smith, J. C. C. C. This is the last Will
and Testament of me, Sarah Hill Norris Wife of
James B. Norris of Chatham County aforesaid, made
by virtue of the power of appointment granted and
renewed to me in summer hereinafter mentioned
Wills by and under a certain deed or bill of
sale made and executed on the twenty first day
of June in the present year, One thousand eight
hundred & thirty four, the following negro Slaves,
that is to say, a negro boy, Simon, his sister, a negro
woman, Suee and her two children Rose and Ka
chil were granted bargained & sold by Mary Pitt
man to Shephard Williams in Trust for and for
for the sole & separate use & benefit of me for and

during my natural life & term & after my death here
 in trust for the use of my body that I shall be living at the
 time of my death, but if I should die having no issue
 of my body surviving, then in trust for such person
 or persons and for such uses, intents & purposes as
 I shall by my last Will & testament or instrument in
 the nature of a last Will & testament or other instru-
 ment signed & sealed in the presence of two or more
 witnesses direct, limit & appoint. And if the said
 said Will & term in execution of the said power of
 appointment and of any and any other power enabling
 me in this behalf to do by this my last Will & tes-
 tament or writing in the nature of a will, direct &
 appoint that term & after my death & in default of
 such issue as aforesaid, the said negro slaves &
 the future issue & increase of the families shall go
 remain & be to the said Sir James Williams his he-
 reafter administrators & assigns shall stand & be en-
 titled to & interested in the same in trust for my said
 husband James B. Peris, his Executors adminis-
 trators & assigns accordingly. And I do hereby nomi-
 nate & appoint my said husband James B. Peris
 the executor of this my last will & testament. In Wit-
 ness whereof I have set my hand and seal this 22nd
 day of August in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight
 hundred & thirty four.
