- My worldly goods I dispose of in the following manner. —
1. I desire that after my interment my funeral
expences be paid out of my Estate.
2. I give to my sister Frances Cooper during her
natural life my two negro slaves, to wit, Prince &
Moses. at the death of my said sister F. Cooper I
give and bequeath the said negroes Mary & Prince to
my niece Sarah Cooper to her heirs and assigns for
ever. — 4. I give to my sister Mary S. Adams
and to her heirs and assigns my negro woman named
Thestor with her issue. 5. I give to my sister Frances
Cooper my horse and gig. 6 I give to my sister Mary
S. Adams my gold watch. 7. I give to my cousin Jas
Barnard my double barrel gun. 8. I give to John Self
my two pistols. — 9. It is my desire that my Island
known by the name of Long Island be sold, and the
proceeds arising from said sale with my interest in the
present crop with my cousin James Barnard be approp-
riated to the discharge of my just and lawful debts and
the residue, if any, I give to my sisters Frances Cooper
and Mary S. Adams for their mutual support. In witness
