I Sarahtha sister of the City of Cincinnati (early and late African Union, being of some anti-slavery mind) and memory to make and publish this my last will & testament in manner & form following, that is to say, I Sarahtha do will and I do hereby send, that all my property left together, with all my just debts and, and - I Sarahtha give and bequeath unto my friend William (the children of my son John Sarah) a black woman slave named Polly, with her issue, to my said friend William their heirs and assigns forever - (That) I give and bequeath unto my friend Doctor Lewis, the sum of Ten, Ten, Ten dollars, to be paid him from the first proceeds of my property in lawful manner of the United States - Finally I give

know and beguile being my friend & sister & her
and affluence & power, the same as of my father with
real and personal, of which I may be proud & my
kind of the inheritance by inheritance. Right I have
and particularly request that my executor take the property
bequeathed to my son Gordon Miller in trust for him,
and place and manage the same to such advantage as may
be, consistently with the best interests of my said son
Miller. In the event of the decease of my son Gordon
Miller without lawful issue then and without care it is
my desire and I do hereby direct that the same property
be equally divided between my son Asa Miller and the
children of my son Thomas M. Miller and the
children of my son John Miller to be held by them the
said and legacies forever. Now I do hereby appoint
my son John Miller the sole guardian of the children
right I do hereby constitute and appoint my sons
John Miller and Lewis Eugene Miller, William Miller &
Eugene Miller Executors, Executors of this my last will
and testament, and Trustees of the estate of my son
Gordon Miller. In witness whereof I have hereunto
