I Catherine E. Barnard, widow of the late Timothy J. Barnard of Chatham County being of sound mind and disposing memory, and in usual good health, but mindful of the uncertainty of life and desiring to make disposition after my death of such worldly goods and estate as it has pleased God to bless me with in this life do make this my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking and amending all and every will and wills hitherto at any time made by me.

Whereas I own and possess in my own right the Lot of Land and Brick Store thereon, known as Shads Building being the Second Tenement East from Whitaker Street on Trust Lot Letter C Duly platted Johnston signed and at present occupied by Glavin agent as a Carpet Store

And Whereas I own an interest in the improvements on the adjoining part of the same lot west of the above described property and lying on Whitaker Street, to the amount of Three Thousand five Hundred Dollars and also a tract of land on Wilmington Islands in Chatham County and known as Whiting's Point and also one other tract of land and known as the Homestead Plantation Called China Grove or Shads Point on Wilmington Island, in which I am entitled to one sixth $\frac{1}{6}$ part, also Fifteen Shares in the Capital Stock of the Mutual Insurance Company

First. I desire my Executors hereinafter named, as soon after my death as may be convenient to my estate, to pay and satisfy all and every just debt or debts which I may leave due and owing by me at my death of any such debts I should leave unpaid.

Second. I give devise and bequeath to my grand daughter Caroline Marion Rowland only child of my late daughter Caroline Rowlands the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to be invested for her benefit by my Executors during her infancy and to be paid to her at maturity or day of her marriage whichever shall happen first. And should my said grand daughter depart this life in infancy and accumulate and without leaving issue living at the time of her death, then the said Five Hundred Dollars to be equally divided among and paid to my remaining executors and legatees in this my last will mentioned.

Third. The whole of my property and Estate herein before specified as also any monies that may be due me on my annuity Bonds given by Mr. John R. Barnard and the late Timothy J. Barnard Executors of Timothy Barnard deceased and all other property taken up out of every kind and

descriptions whatsoever which I may acquire or possess or entitled
to at the time of my death, I give devise and bequeath to my two
Children, Solomon S. Barnards and Virginia Patchard, sons of
William R. Patchard and my said Grand Child Caroline Marion
Renshaw to be equally divided between them share and share alike
in the manner and for the purposes following.

The first portion or share falling to my
said Son Solomon S. Barnard, I give devise and bequeath to him
his heirs executors and administrators or and upon the following
Conditions and Trusts viz Our Trust to apply the annual income and
profits to the maintenance and support of his wife and Children
during his life not in any manner subject to the debts Contracts and
liabilities of my said Son Solomon S. Barnard either now existing or
that may hereafter be incurred by him and after the death of my
said Son Solomon S. then the services or share aforesaid to be held
upon the same trusts for the benefit of the Widow and Children of
the said Solomon S. during her widowhood or natural life and
upon her marriage or death then to such Child or Children of
the said Solomon S. as may be then living. The Child or Chil-
dren of a deceased Child to take the share its Parent would
have been entitled of in life and in default of such living
at the time of the death of both said Solomon S. and his said
wife or his remarriage then to the said Virginia Patchard and
Caroline Marion Renshaw share and share alike to them and
their heirs forever.

And whereas I have purchased from my
said Son Solomon S. Barnard all his interest and Estate
in remainder which he was entitled to under the Will of
his late Grand father Solomon Shadrack which consists in
particulars of an undivided one thirds of Westown portion of
First Lot Letter C Derby Ward Johnston & Ward in the City of
Marietta and the Buck Building or Store thereto being the
Westown Store in that range known as the in said City as Shady
Buildings situate on Whittaker Street, and also an undivided
one third interest in remainder in and to the following named
Negro Slaves to wit Nancey Emilia Abolomah Marguerite
Little Caesar Big Caesar Henry Fredrick Dennis Oliver
Ames Robert Delano Compton Pascilla and Lucy
and also whatsoever other Estate and remainder the said
Solomon S. was entitled to under the last Will of his Grand
father Solomon Shadrack.

Now I do hereby give devise and
bequeath unto my said Son Solomon S. Barnard and
his heirs executors and administrators the aforesaid
undivided one third of the said Lot Letter C and
the St. thereon and also and undivided one third
of the aforesaid Negro Slaves and further any other
Estate or property I may have taken under the aforesaid
Conveyance from said Solomon S. to me, to be by him
held upon the same Conditions and terms as aforesaid

and declared in relation to the legatees heruntofore made to
him forth the eight partition or share falling to my daughter Margaret
Porter
