One about twenty four years of age Sam about nineteen
years of age Maria about sixteen years of age and

Sarah about eight years of age in trust nevertheless
to have and to hold the same in trust to and for
the sole and separate use of my Grand daughter
Sarah Anne Bee and Electa Lee Bee, the daughters
of my son Richard S A Bee, share and share alike and
free from all liabilities for the debts contracts or engage-
ments of any husband whom they or either of them
may marry - Fourth the rest and residue of my prop-
erty real and personal, which I shall have at the time
of my death including what shall remain of the
proceeds of the sale of the woman Charlotte devoted
in the Liberators Office of this my last will and Testament
Egive devise and bequeath to my son Richard S A
Bee William S Bee and Barnard E Bee and Eugene
M Bee share and share alike to them their heirs and
assigns forever Fifth I nominate and appoint my
said son Barnard E Bee to be the Executor of this my
last will and Testament, and request him to carry
out my wishes herein expressed In testimony
