Item Third - After the payment of my just debts and funeral expenses, I
give devise and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Cullen all the
property and Estate, real, personal, or mixed of which I
shall die seized or possessed, or to which I shall be entitled at
the time of decease.

The Will of Stephen E Watersham of Chatham County in the State of Georgia executed in Savannah.

In the name of God Amen
I Stephen E Watersham of the County of Chatham State of Georgia the aforesaid being of sound and disposing mind do make publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament Revoking any and all by me heretofore made.

Item First

I direct that all my debts be paid out of the income arising from my interest in the Grove Plantation Situate in Chatham County and the Slaves thereon amounting to about one hundred and seven except a debt of Nine thousand Dollars due to my sister Isabella R Morgan which I direct to remain as a charge upon my Estate until the claims payment thereof.

Item Second

After the payments of my said debts excepting the said Nine thousand dollars I direct that the following legacies be paid out of the income in the first Item set forth as it may accrue but without interest.

Do my Cousin Robert R Watersham five hundred dollars

Do my aunt Mrs Boone one thousand dollars

Do my aunt Mrs Barnwell one thousand dollars.

Do my Cousin Stephen Elliott Jr five hundred dollars.

Do my Cousin Fredericks A. Watersham five hundred dollars

Do my aunt Mrs Susan Watersham five Shares in the Savannah Albany & Gulf R R Co.

Item Third

It is my will and I direct that during the period that the debts and legacies are being paid as aforesaid that there shall be paid from the income aforesaid in the First Item set forth the sum of one thousand dollars annually on the first day of January unto my sister Isabella R Watersham in addition to the interest due upon my said debt of Nine thousand dollars this legacy to be a primary charge.
