Great Britain and Ireland called England but now
residing in the City of Savannah in the County of Chatham
and State of Georgia in the United States of America being
of sound mind and disposing memory in view of the
uncertainty of life and the certainty of death and with the
desire herein to dispose of all my temporal affairs do make
declare and publish this my last will and testament
hereby expressly revoking any and all wills and testaments
by me at any time heretofore made

Item First I direct that after I shall have departed
this life my body be committed to the earth in a decent

Item Second I direct the payment by my executors herein
after named of all my just debts as soon as the same
conveniently pay the same

I have Third I give devise and bequeath unto my friend George

soever situate And being in England aforesaid Consisting
in part of that Certain piece or parcel of Ground

of Northam aforesaid late in the occupation Henry
Mearns now or late of John Calverworthy and Grace
Burdick as tenants thereof to me the said Robert

Ninty seven feet or thereabouts And in breadth
