 my Executors to be hereinafter named, shall dispose of all my
 property both real and personal, either at public or private sale
 as to my said Executors may seem best, the proceeds thereof
 to be disposed of as follows, to-wit:

I direct that all my just and lawful debts shall be paid
 together with the expenses of my funeral, If I do not have
 done so in my life time, I direct that my Executors
