I Maria Edwards of the city of Savannah County
of Chatham County State of Georgia being of sound
mind disposing mind and memory do make
publish and declare this instrument of writing
to be my last will and testament hereby revoking
and annulling by me at any time heretofore made
any will or wills that all my just debts be first paid
by my Executors hereinafter named.

I give devise and bequeath unto Sarah Felligant
widow of Henry Felligant the sum of one hundred
dollars in full payment —

I also devise and bequeath unto Frances Pickens
of the city of Savannah the sum of Five hundred
dollars in full payment —

I give devise and bequeath unto my Executors the
following named negro slaves to wit Henry and
Margaret their heirs together with their future
increase in manner following to wit: That the said
negro Henry and his heirs shall be in the
care and custody the protection of my Executors when
they shall be of good health, she is to pay to said Executors
the sum of Five Dollars in monthly when said servant
shall be sick or afflicted, and to pay her medical
attention, and the cost of my Estate when Henry
shall be sick or afflicted, her health I desire that said
said Henry be permitted to remain with his mother Mary
until Henry attains the age of twelve years when provided
that Henry shall be bound and trained, she also
shall pay to said Executors the sum of ten Dollars
per month as wages, all such wages to be appropriated
to the support of my Estate —

I give devise and bequeath that the
negro slaves to wit of my Executors hereinafter
named Mary and Henry and of them or their heirs
be to after my death —

I will the rest and residue of my Estate both real
and personal and whatsoever situated and of every
sort and descriptions whatsoever I give devise and
bequeath unto Isaac Warner and Geo. W. Davis and
the survivors of them and the Executors and adminis-
trators of such survivor of such survivor and
their Successors in the Trust —

I do hereby and do hold — the same in trust
nevertheless to and for the joint use benefit and behoof
of my three Grand Children to wit John S. Montmiller
Edw. Montmiller and Harriet Montmiller and the
survivors or survivor of them for and during their

Natural lives and the natural life of the longest
 lives of them —

— The Trustees, following that is to say to "devote the rents, incomes and profits and profits of my said Trust and Residue of my said Estate, to accumulate, and it is my express will and desire, that the same shall be committed, to accumulate, and be by the said Trustees and the Survivors of them, the administrators and Executors of such Survivors, and Thos and his Successors in the Trust, in whole, or some other suitable, form until, the youngest of my said named Grand Children shall attain the age of Twenty One years —

years then in trust to convey my said, last and
Residue of my said Estate immediately upon the death
of the said Trustee, with all accumulations, income
profits Rent and Rents, as aforesaid, in due equal
proportions as aforesaid to the said General Society
and the Methodist Episcopal Church of Savannah
as aforesaid in fee simple.
