Savannah County. — In the name of God Amen!

I, Elizabeth Riley, of the City of Savannah, County and State aforesaid, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make, publish and declare this Instrument of writing to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all Wills and Testaments by me at any time heretofore made. —

Item First. I desire that all my just debts be first paid as soon as convenient after my decease, by my Executors, herein-after named. —

Item Second. I give devise and bequeath the two wooden frame Houses on Harris Street in the City of Savannah, next door to the land of the premises now occupied by me and all the interest which I own in the Lots upon which the same are located to Aaron Champion of the City of Savannah, in Trust nevertheless to have and to hold the same to and for the sole, separate and exclusive use benefit and behoof of Ann Reilly, Sister of my deceased Husband William Riley, and the wife of John Riley — to and for the term of her natural life, free from the debts contract contrary and control of her present, and of any future husband with whom she may intermarry, and from and immediately on death, then in further trust to convey the same to such child or children or representative or representatives of child or children of the said Ann Riley as may be living at the time of her death, share and share alike as tenants in common and not as Joint Tenants, Children and Grand Children to represent their Parents and Grand Parents, and in her own stripes and not per capita. —

Item Third. The Brick House upon Harris Street in the City of Savannah in which I now reside, and the Lot upon which the same is located, I give devise and bequeath unto Christopher James Abbott, the nephew of my deceased Husband William Riley, to have and to hold the same to him his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns in fee-simple forever. —

Item Fourth. I give devise and bequeath unto my niece Ann Rehill, Fifteen (15) Shares of the Capital Stock of the Central Rail Road and Banking Company of Georgia, in fee simple forever. —

Item Fifth. I give devise and bequeath unto Julia Ann O'Riley Daughter of Charles O'Riley, and niece of my deceased Husband William Riley, five (5) Shares of the Capital Stock of the Central Rail Road and Banking Company of Georgia, in fee simple forever. —

Item Sixth. I give devise and bequeath unto "The Sisters of the order of Our Lady of Mercy" Five (5) Shares of the Capital Stock of the Central Rail Road and Banking Company of Georgia, to have and to hold the same to and for the use benefit and behoof of such orphan Children as now are, or who may hereafter be placed under their charge. —

Item Seventh. I give devise and bequeath unto the Reverend Peter Whelan Five (5) Shares of the Capital Stock of the Central Rail Road and Banking Company of Georgia, to have and to hold the same to him and the successors in his office, in trust nevertheless to and for the use benefit and behoof of the Male Orphans who now are and who may hereafter be under the care of the Church of Saint John the Baptist in the City of Savannah. —

Item Eighth. All the rest and residue of my Estate Real Personal and mixed of what sort soever, and wheresoever located, I give devise and bequeath unto the said Christopher James Abbott, Ann Reehill, John Ann Riley, and the children of the said Ann Riley, (said children to take one share of said Residuary Estate) who may now be living or who may hereafter be born in lawful wedlock. - the above named persons to share and share alike. —

Item Ninth. I hereby nominate constitute and appoint John C Ward, and George A. Coulter of the City of Savannah, as the Executors of this my Last Will and Testament. —

Now therefore I Elizabeth Reilly of the City of Savannah, County of Chatham and State of Georgia do make publish and declare this instrument of writing to be a Codicil to my said Last Will and Testament, hereby ratifying and confirming all and every my said last Will and Testament except in manner following, to wit,

Item First. I do hereby of my said Will is hereby annulled and declared void and of none effect. And the legacy therein mentioned is revoked; and the five (5) Shares of the Capital Stock of The Central Rail Road and Banking Company of Georgia therein mentioned, I give devise and bequeath unto my Niece Ann Reehill, to have and to hold the same to her, her heirs Executors and assigns in fee simple forever.

Item Second I give devise and bequeath unto Ann Riley mother of my deceased Husband William Riley Five Shares of the Capital Stock of The Central Rail Road and Banking Company.
