my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all Wills by me
at any time heretofore made - And first I commit my Soul
to God who gave it, and my body I desire to be buried in
the family burial ground, in the Evergreen Cemetery at
Bonaventure and my worldly Estate I dispose as follows

1. I will all my Just debts to be paid

2. All the real and personal Estate now in action and
property of every nature kind and description of which I
may be possessed or to which I may hereafter become entitled
in any way or manner whatever or wherever, whether by inheritance
or otherwise. I give devise and bequeath unto my Well beloved
and trusty Friends Captain John W. Anderson and Honorable
Thomas Ware In Trust, however in the first Place to pay
my debts and funeral expenses, and in the second Place
to appropriate the rents and profits of my Property after
my debts and funeral expenses are paid to the joint
Support and benefit of my Wife and children until
the youngest child shall become Twenty One years of
age - 3^d I do not wish my Property divided until
my youngest child shall attain the age of Twenty One
years, then I wish my Property to be divided into three
equal parts, one equal third part thereof I give
devise and bequeath unto my dearly beloved Wife Sarah
Ann Talligant in lieu of her dower or third part

not Subject or liable to the debts Contracts & Control or engagements of any future Husband - The remaining two equal third parts I give devise and bequeath into my children Sarah Ann Vay Wagner, Mary Rulledge Falligant, Fanny Ingenuis Falligant Ann Della Stephens Falligant Eliza Calhoun Falligant and John Anderson Falligant. Share and Share alike - The parts coming to each of my aforesaid daughters to be held by the Trustees hereinbefore named for the sole use and benefit of such daughters, not liable or Subject to the debts Contracts engagements or Control of any Husband or Husbands with whom my said daughters or either of them have or may have intermarried, or may hereafter intermarry - Should either of my said children delect this life before my youngest child arrives to the age of twenty one year without leaving a child or children of her or his living at the time of her or his death, then such child's share is to go to and be equally divided among the Survivors of my children - Should either of my children delect this life before my youngest child arrives to the age of twenty one year leaving a child or children living at the time of his or her death, then such child's share is to go to such child or children I send children to Represent their Parents and to take for their and not for Cashiers share & share alike to them their heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever - Should all of my children die without leaving issue before my youngest child attains the age of twenty one year then all of my property is to go to my wife Sarah Ann Falligant if she be then in life and remain my widow, but if she be not then in life or again married then all of my property except her one third is to go to my beloved relatives, who may then be in life share and share alike their heirs and assigns for ever

Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my friends Carl John W Anderson & Hon Thomas Pierce as Executors of this my Last Will and Testament - In testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and Seal and published and declared this to be my Last Will and Testament in the presence of the witnesses named below this twenty third day of August A D eighteen hundred & fifty
