also the sum of Five Hundred Dollars
\$500 to be placed in trust of his mother
Anna Smith for his education and sole use
and benefit

Fourth I give and bequeath to my
beloved wife Ellen Holland the whole
residue of my Estate, namely my Stock
in trade, Book accounts, Household and Kitchen
furniture all other monies and valuables of
whatsoever kind remaining after the pay-
ment of my aforesaid bequests

Fifth I appoint and select my friend
David Osmond my Executor to carry out this
my Will and Testament
