

Chatham County - I James Love of the City of Savannah  
County and State aforesaid being sick and infirm in body  
but of sound mind and <sup>disposing</sup> do make publish and  
declare this my Last Will and Testament hereby revoking  
and annulling all Wills heretofore at any time made  
by me - First - I give devise and bequeath unto my son  
Henry Love and to his heirs, executors and administrators  
the following property real and personal to wit, The Weston  
Half Part of Lot Number Four (4) Carpenter's Tract in Dickey  
Ward, also one half part of Lot number Seven (7) Reynolds  
Ward, also the Southern half part of Lot number Eleven (11)  
in Orange Street, also one half part of Lot number  
Twenty Three (23) Wesley Ward, also one half part of  
Lot number Forty-one (41) Calhoun Ward, all of  
Said Lots being in the Said City of Savannah, also  
one undivided one half of Garden Lots numbers Forty-  
Three (43) and Forty-four (44) East and recently  
Surveyed and laid out into City Lots by William  
Belvin Senior City Surveyor, also Garden Lot  
number one hundred and Sixty, East 1/16 of Con-  
taining Five and Seven tenths acres ( $5\frac{7}{10}$ ) also  
one undivided one half of Lot number Five in  
Calhoun Chatham County lying east of two miles  
Stones on the White Bluff Road, and also all of my  
Lands and real Estate lying in the County of Effingham  
and State of Georgia on the South Side of the Barn  
Pike Road - Also the following named Negro Slaves  
Sixteen in number Fourtuck Mairia Amy Rose  
Jack Six years old Polly Richard Rachel Reuben  
Jenny, Lewis, Allen George, Hannah Sunday & Alfred

Second, I give devise and bequeath  
unto my wife Ann Love for and during the term  
of her natural life the sum of Six Hundred Dollars per  
annum to be paid to her monthly that is to say Fifty  
dollars per month, this bequest I intend to be in the  
form and freed of dower and of all other claims  
she may have against my Estate, and not to take  
effect if the Said Ann Love shall set up any claim  
for dower or any claim against my Estate, and I  
charge the annuity aforesaid of Six Hundred dollars  
per annum, during the life of the said Ann Love upon  
that portion of my Estate herein bequeathed to my Son  
Henry Love, and direct the same to be paid by him.

Third, I give devise and bequeath  
unto my son John Love to hold by him held in Trust  
for the sole and exclusive use of his wife and children  
paid entirely from his individual debts and contracts  
the following lands and real Estate fourth, all of my  
Lands lying in the County of Effingham and State

of Georgia on the north side of the town of Newnan also  
Lot number Eleven, Section fifteen on the fourth district  
Cherokee, containing one hundred and fifty acres, and  
Lots numbers eight hundred and one fourth Section first  
district, two hundred and forty-third Section Second  
district, Lot number four hundred and fifty one, eight  
tenth Section Third district, all in Cherokee and containing  
forty acres each - Fourth - I give devise and bequeath  
unto my son Andrew Love my tract of land in the  
County of Bryan purchased from John Clayton con-  
taining eight hundred acres, also another lot in said  
County of Bryan purchased from Purcell Lanius con-  
taining three hundred and fifty acres, also Lot number  
fifty six in the fifth District of Lee County Georgia, also  
the following named five lots in Cherokee Georgia viz num-  
ber one hundred and ninety four, Seventh Section Second  
number nine hundred and eighty two, fifth Section first district  
number one thousand and fifty eight, fifth Section first district  
number twelve hundred and forty five eleventh Section first  
district, number twelve hundred and seventy third Section  
fourth district, the first containing one hundred and sixty  
and the remaining four forty acres each - Fifth - I give  
devise and bequeath to my Grand Children, the children  
of my Son James Love equally to be divided between them  
my tract of land lying in the County of Bryan, contain-  
ing Two thousand Seven Hundred acres and principally  
known as the Catarin & Edwards Tracts, nineteen hundred  
and fifty acres of which was conveyed to me by West Edwards  
and the remainder by several different persons, and in-  
cluding also my late residence in Bryan County - Also  
the following five lots of land in Cherokee Georgia viz Lot  
number two hundred and eighty three, Twenty seventh Section  
Second district containing one hundred and fifty acres, Lot  
number nine hundred and nine fifth Section first dis-  
trict, Lot number one hundred and four fourth Section  
first district, Lot number Seven hundred and Thirty five  
fourteenth Section first district and Lot number five hun-  
dred and ninety five, fourth Section first district the  
last four containing forty acres each - Sixth - I give  
devise and bequeath unto my son Charles Love the res-  
idue of my lands in Bryan County comprising about  
thirteen hundred, four hundred of which were granted  
to James Love, Two hundred to Brock Cribbs, two hundred  
and fifty were purchased of John Thompson, three  
hundred from John Taylor first and one hundred and  
twenty bought at Sale of Hinkley's, and also the following  
five lots of land in Cherokee Georgia viz. Lot number  
two hundred and eighty three fifth Section Second district  
containing one hundred and fifty acres - Lot num-  
ber three, hundred and three hundred and third Section first

Lot number four hundred and Seventy-four Thirteenth  
Section first district - Lot number two hundred and  
Sixty Thirteenth Section first district and Lot number  
Four Hundred and thirty five, Thirteenth Section first  
district, the last four containing forty acres each.)

Seventh - I give devise and bequeath

unto my Grand children, the children of Obidiah Elmore  
by my daughter Anna, Lot number Six<sup>(6)</sup> in the tenth  
district of Early County Georgia and Lot number one  
hundred and Sixty two in the twenty-seventh district  
of Lee County Georgia - Eighth - I give devise and bequeath  
unto my Son Henry Love all of his Grand Father's fur-  
niture in Bryan and Effingham Counties, consisting  
of two dining Tables, one Round Table, one Chest of  
drawers, one China Dow, Clock and One Gold Watch  
and Chain in Ninth - The rest residue and remainder  
of my Estate real personal and mixed of whatsoever  
description the same may be or where soever  
described the same may be or where soever situated  
after the payment of all of my just debts and  
funeral expenses. I do give devise and bequeath  
unto my Said Son Henry Love whom I declare to be  
the residuary Legatee under this my Will. And  
lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint  
my Said Son Henry Love Sole executor of this my  
Last Will & Testament. In witness whereof I have  
hereunto set my Hand and Seal this eighth day  
of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
hundred and fifty Seven ... H. Love (P.P.)

to sell my Negro woman Charlotte about forty five years  
of age for what price ever at public or private sale and  
without applying to any Court of Law or Equity to do  
so - Second I give devise and bequeath to my son Barnard  
all my Gold watch and chain and my home and

Third I give devise and bequeath to my  
said son Barnard the following Negro slaves, to wit  
One about twenty four years of age Sam about nineteen  
years of age Maria
