Do make and publish this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all Wills, by me at any time heretofore made - And first I commit my soul to God who gave it: And my body I desire to be Buried in the Family Burial grounds, Lot Number nine hundred and sixty three (1963) in Laurel Grove Cemetery, in the City of Savannah and my worldly Estate I dispose of as follows -

Item First. - I devise that all my just debts, and funeral expenses, be first paid by my Executors hereinafter named -

Item Second. I give devise and bequeath unto my Daughter Eliza Hay the sum of Five hundred Dollars in fee Simple -

Item Third. I give devise and bequeath unto my son John W Nostrand the sum of Five hundred Dollars in fee Simple -

Item Fourth. I give devise and bequeath unto my grand Daughter Julia M. Flanders the sum of Five hundred Dollars in fee Simple -

Item Fifth. I give devise and bequeath unto my grand Daughter Mary M. Flanders the sum of Two hundred Dollars in fee Simple -

Item Sixth. It is my express Will, and desire, that the foregoing Legacies be paid by my Executors - hereinafter named, without delay and as soon as conveniently can be done after my death -

Item Seventh. I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Ann Nostrand, all the Rest of my Estate, Both Real, and personal, Including household and Kitchen Furniture, goods chattels &c in fee Simple -

Item Eighth. I do also appoint and desire, that Edward Lovel act as Trustee for my two grand Daughters (V.S.) Julia M Flanders and Mary M. Flanders -

Item Ninth. Also I do herein, and hereby, Appoint Ann Nostrand and Edward Lovel Co Executors to this my last will and Testament -
