- 4 Fourthly I give and bequeath all the residue of my property
to my nephew Samuel C. Delano and my niece
Elizabeth Delano Children of my said sister share and
share alike said property to be divided when my
said nephew arrives at the age of twenty one years
his share to be paid over to him at that time And
my said niece to receive her share when she shall
arrive at the age of twenty one years if she be

mean time and until my said nephew shall arrive at the age of twenty one years the proceeds and income of the said property are to be paid to my said nephew and mine in equal parts as the said proceeds and income shall accrue

5th Fifth I appoint my friend William Edriss of Savannah in the State of Georgia to be Executor of this my last will and testament and hereby authorize him at any time when he shall think proper to sell the whole or any part of my said property without any order of Court for that purpose and to convert the proceeds thereof in such manner as he shall think best and in this or any other State and to hold the same so be invested subject to the provisions of this will

Will of Robert Diamond

In the name of God amen
I, Robert Diamond late of the parish of Northam in the County of Devon in that part of the Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland called England but now residing in the City of Savannah in the County of Chatham and State of Georgia in the United States of America being of sound mind and disposing memory in view of the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death and with the advice herein to dispose of all my temporal affairs do make declare and publish this my last will and testament hereby expressly revoking any and all wills and testaments by me at any time heretofore made

Item First I direct that after I shall have departed this life my body be committed to the earth in a decent manner

Item Second I direct the payment by my Executors herein after named of all my just debts as soon as the same conveniently pay the same

Item Third I give devise and bequeath unto my friend George Moore of the said City of Savannah and to his heirs by executors and administrators all my goods and chattles lands tenements and hereditaments where soever situated or being in the said the United States of America

Item Fourth I give devise and bequeath unto my friend Moses Levy of Warron one hundred and nine good Lane Maunds - ditch and Warron Ten Saddlebush horses
