1st Item. I commit my body to the Earth and my soul to God who gave it

2nd Item. I desire that all my just debts and funeral Expenses shall be paid by my Executor hereinafter named as soon after my death as shall to him be convenient.

3rd Item. I give to my beloved Wife Catherine O'Donnell forever, all of my household and kitchen furniture with the exception of One Washboard, which I give to my brother James O'Donnell

4th Item. I give devise and bequeath unto my said brother James O'Donnell, my house situated on lot leased from Abraham Minis in the City of Savannah together with the lease of said lot to him his heirs and assigns forever

5th Item. I give to my said brother James O'Donnell forever the entire Stock in trade in my barroom situated on West Broad Street in the City of Savannah and known as the O'Donnell Shades, out of the proceeds arising from the keeping of said Barroom I desire my brother, to support my Wife Catherine as long as she shall remain single and also out of said proceeds, as far as they will extend to educate as he thinks proper, my nephew James Brady and my nephew James O'Donnell

6th Item. I give devise and bequeath to my said brother James O'Donnell his heirs and assigns forever my Houses situated on leased land in Cherry Street New York City

Lastly, I nominate constitute and appoint my brother James O'Donnell Executor of this my last Will and Testament
