and for the trusts intents and purposes hereinafter  
expressed and declared of and concerning the same And I give and bequeath  
all my lease hold estates, lands, messuages and  
tenements and all my goods, chattels, money and  
effects whatsoever for money and other personal estate  
and effects whatsoever and wheresoever of or  
to which I shall be possessed or entitled at the  
time of my decease unto the said John Wolford  
and John James Wolford their Executors administrators  
and assigns upon and for the trusts  
intents and purposes herein after expressed and  
declared of and concerning the same. And I  
declare my Will to be that the said Real and
