This is my will
William Rods

Swanwick Sept 5th 1854

Dear Friend

I hope that you as my friends will faithfully execute my will. The address direction of my father is the following. Johann Burde Altrachhausen, Kingdom of Hanover. The servant girl staying with me Henry Rods shall receive \$400. (say four hundred dollars) and hold this give her the cow and calf and all the furniture there. You shall take \$100. (say one hundred dollars) to fence in the burial ground and put it in order. \$500 hundred dollars are here in the bank \$200 (two hundred do) are in your hands. \$1000 (ten hundred do) are in the hands of J. B. Miller New York. You may all the store and defray from the purchase money your expenses you & Miller in New York must look to it that all my affairs are arranged. I have four parents and sisters in Germany and therefore you must provide that all the money left will get into their hands. This is my last will I certify it by my signature
