

Will & testament of Ann C. Sandergreen

State of Georgia Chatham County

In the name of God, Amen:
I Ann C. Sandergreen, of the State and County
above named, being now of sound and dispos-
ing mind and memory, but knowing the un-
certainty of this mortal life, do make, publish
and declare this my last will and testament,
hereby revoking all former wills by me at any
time heretofore made

First: I hereby will and direct that my funeral
expenses and just debts be paid by my Executors
hereinafter named, out of such estate as I may
leave; and as to the rest and residue of my worldly
estate with which it has pleased God to bless me
I dispose of the same as follows, namely:

Second: I give and bequeath all the property
of which I may die seized & possessed, if what-
ever it may consist and wherever situated,
(after payment of my funeral expenses and just
debts) unto my beloved mother Rebecca A. =
Worton, to have and to hold the same to
and for her own use and benefit for and
during the term of her natural life; and after
the death of my said mother then I give and
bequeath the said property of every description
and wherever situated unto my Executors herein-
after named and to the survivor of them, and
to the Executors and Administrators of such
survivor, to have and to hold the same In Trust
for the sole and separate use of my sister

Charlotte M. Sweet wife of Farley R. Sweet of
Savannah, for and during the term of her
natural life, not subject to the control or debts
of her present or any future husband and from
and after the decease of my said sister, then to
convey and deliver the same to such person or
person as she may direct, by her last will and
testament, or any instrument in the nature
thereof; and should my sister fail to dispose
of the same by will, then to convey and deliver
the same to such child or children of my said
sister as may be living at the time of her
death, share and share alike

Third: I do hereby nominate and appoint my
friends Doctor Benjamin Sweet, and Saml B
Sweet Executors of this my last will and tes-
tament, and trustees under the same. In

Will of James Etow Strike

In the name of God, Amen! I James
Etow Strike of the City of Savannah and State
of Georgia, Bachelor, being in good health of
body, and of sound and disposing mind and
memory (praised be God for the same) and being
desirous of disposing of what property I may own
when called, to pay the last great debt of nature
do make and publish this my last will and
testament. As to such property which I may
own at the time of my death, I dispose of the
same as follows.

Imprimis, I desire all my debts (if any) should be
paid.

Item, I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved
niece Helen A Arnold daughter of my beloved
sister and of her husband Richard D Arnold ill
of Savannah all the property of which I may
die possessed or to which I may be entitled at
the time of my decease of whatsoever kind real
personal and mixed wheresoever situate, and I
herby direct my executors herein after named to
hold the property herein and hereby devised and be-
queathed free from the debts and engagements
of my husband with whom my said niece may
intermarry, it being my desire that she may have
the exclusive control and benefit of any property
she may derive from this my will - and it is
my desire should any of such property remain
at the time of her decease that it shall pass
to such person or persons as my said niece shall
by deed or by her last will appoint and designate

Item I herby appoint my friend and brother-
in-law Richard D Arnold ill D sole executor
of this my last will and testament. In witness
