same as follows.

paid.

Then, I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved
niece Helena St Arnold daughter of my beloved
sister and of her husband Richard, D Arnold M.D
of Savannah all the property of which I may
die possessed or to which I may be entitled, at
the time of my decease of whatsoever kind real
personal and mixed wheresoever situated, and I
herby direct my executors herein after named to
hold the property herein and hereby devised and be-
queathed free from the debts control and engagements
of my husband with whom my said niece may
infirmance it being my desire that she may have
the exclusive control and benefit of any property
she may derive from this my will - and it is
my desire should any of such property remain
at the time of her decease that it shall pass
to such person or persons as my said niece shall
by deed or by her last will appoint and designate
