of Chatham and State of Georgia, being of sound
and disposing mind and memory, Do make pub-
lish and declare this to be my last Will and
Testament -

Item First I direct my Executors herein after named -
out of my Estate to pay to my beloved Mother
Priscilla Foley, the sum of One Hundred Dollars, an-
nually, so long as she may live -

Item Second I direct my Executors herein after named out
of my Estate to pay to my beloved Sister Sarah
Green the Wife of Patrick Green, the sum of
One hundred Dollars, annually, so long as she
may live

Item Third I direct my Executors herein after named,
out of my Estate, to pay to Mary M^cCartick
commonly called Mary Foley the sum of Fifty
Dollars, annually, so long as she may live

Item Fourth I direct all my Estate real personal and
mixed, to be divided into three equal parts, and
Subject to the Annuitites herein before given, which
I do make chargeable upon all my Estate - I give,
devise and bequeath one third of all my Estate, charge-
able as aforesaid to my beloved Wife Louisa Foley
her Heirs, Executors, Administrators & Assigns forever -
One third of all my Estate chargeable as aforesaid
I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved Son
Francis Foley his Heirs, Executors, Administrators &
Assigns forever, and the other third of my Estate chargeable as aforesaid
I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved daughter
Catherine Foley her Heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns forever

Item fifth I nominate constitute and appoint the said
John T. Stuby and James B. Foley as Executors of
this my last Will and Testament
