all that property known as the Bee House on Drayton Street
City of Savannah to have and to hold the same during
his natural life and then to go to my sister Margaretha
Emily and Kate, and Sarah Petty share and share alike
their heirs and assigns forever.

Thirdly. I give and bequeath to my Son William Henry
Weisberger all the Balance of my property, Real, Personal
and mixed, his heirs and assigns forever, with the
 proviso that the said William Henry Weisberger his heirs
and assigns shall pay over or secure to be paid over
to each of my sisters Sarah Margaretha, Emily & Kate
The sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars per annum in
equal monthly or quarterly instalments as may suit
their convenience, during their natural lives.

And should my Son William Henry Weisberger depart
this life without lawful issue or without having formed
a matrimonial alliance, Then I give devise and be-
queath the same to my brother Isaac Weisberger and
my sons, sisters namely, Eliza, Sarah, Margaretha,
Emily and Catherine, share and share alike their
heirs and assigns forever.

Fourthly. I do nominate and appoint my Son William
Henry Weisberger and my brother Isaac Weisberger together
with William Durcan Esq. to be the Executors of this

publish and declare this instrument in writing to be my last will and
Testament for the use and purposes hereinafter expressed and men-
tioned. And I do hereby by virtue of this instrument, revoke and
annul and make void, all every other instrument in writing of any and
every kind or nature whatsoever, purporting to be in part or in
whole my last will and Testament, previously dated, or in any way
conflicting with this instrument.

First. To all and every person or persons unto whom I shall have sold
or conveyed any property real or personal, derived by donation or
