& Bettoner marry again - I desire that my Executors  
shall give my children Sarah Rebecca & Jeph a fair  
education - I desire that my Executors pay the interest  
for the maintenance and education of my children  
which shall accrue on the other notes - I do hereby app-  
oint my brother Edwin S. Bettoner and Francis Simons  
my Executors of this my last Will and Testament  
signed sealed published and declared, by the said  
Testator as and for his last Will and Testament in the  
presence of us, who at his request in his presence, and  
in the presence of each other, have subscribed our  
names as Witnesses thereto.
