relinquish to my said son Alonzo S Shaw all my right title claim or
interest in or to the following negro slaves namely, Tenah, Ishmael, Charles
and Moses, also being entitled to ten acres in the contemplated land Lottery
I do give and bequeath the same together with all the open named property
Real and personal unto the said Alonzo S Shaw his heirs, executors, admin-
istrators and assigns forever. And I do constitute and appoint the said
Alonzo S Shaw sole executor to this my last will and Testament.
