I Raynes being sick in body but of sound and disposing mind
do declare this to be my last will and testament I give devise
and bequeath all the Estate both real and personal both in posses-
sion and in action of whatsoever nature it may consist to my
Grand son John G Butler Junior the son of John G Butler late
deceased and his heirs forever And its further my will and
desire that should the said John G Butler Junior my grandson
die before he attains the age of twenty one years or without
ifue lawfully begotten then and in that case all the Estate

both real and personal in possession or in action of which I am now possessed and to which I am now entitled or may hereafter be entitled to shall go to the said John G Butler senior and his heirs forever and I do hereby revoke all and any will and testament heretofore made by me and do hereby nominate constitute and appoint the said John G Butler sen^r. the sole executor to this my last will and testament In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty seven.
