veyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien  
convey and confirm unto the said Slaughter Cowling his heirs and  
assigns for ever All that tract or parcel of land containing four  
hundred acres be the same more or less situate lying and being  
in the parish of Saint George then Province now Colony of South  
and State of Georgia aforesaid being and bounding south  
nearly by land of Moses Mumferson every other side by wa-  
ter land at the time of the Original Survey together  
with all and singular the houses Outbuildings  
Buildings improvements hereditaments and appurtenances  
whatsoever on the said tract of land belonging or in-  
tending to appertain to the said Slaughter Cowling his heirs and  
assigns and remainder rents issues & profits thereof & of every  
part and parcel thereof unto the said Slaughter Cowling his heirs and  
assigns forever to him his heirs and assigns forever to have and to  
enjoy in full and quiet possession of them the said William Norment
