back to me and My Heirs Next I bequeath the North part of Lot A 28 Elbert
to my Grand Niece Mary Smith Next I bequeath the North part of Lot A 32
Elbert to my Grand Niece Elizabeth Trumble Hemmick Her father Garden Next I
bequeath the North part of Lot A 10 Germersburg to My Grand Niece Jennet Sherret
I Reserve the 4 Lot on A 28 and 32 A 10 Germersburg for further Consideration
Next my 250 Acre of Land in Jefferson County and My Shop Goods and Cattle and
Horses to be sold and the Money with to be put in the Bank for my Heirs equally
My Negro Wench Betty I bequeath to Jean Sherret My Household furniture is
made over to My Wife Mary Now I Appoint My Friends Jeremiah and Richard
Candler My Executors My Will is to have his Sunday Clothes and Schooling out
of the Bank and Bound to a Gentel trade at fourteen years old Given under my
Hand and Seal this twenty fourth day of June one Thousand eight hundred and
Eighteen and the fourth second and fourth third of the American Independence
and the State and County aforesaid White Silver Spoons I may have I leave
to Jean Sherret and the Silver Candle the Silver Spoon and Stock Buckles to
Mr Sherret My Black trunk with my toiles and peppers I leave to the care
of my Executors the Collection of Rent and Renting Houses John Hunter Will Act
for Mr Langley with the children of 14 yrs old Money to be in Stock till the
Children of 140 My Wife Mary has no Drury upon any of the Lots or any
thing But what on Record if By Misfortune By fore if any of Mr Sonnet and
Jean Sherret and Mary Smith Houses Burnt they must help one another to Build
Mr Sherret to have my Lot and small Mattress two Blankets one Sheet one Coverlet
one quilted My Bible the Description of Scotland and the Wars in Ireland with the
French Grammar and Fables My Coats Books 10 pocketing one large looking Glass
all the Shop Goods and Spinning Wheel and A Round Mahogany Table My bureau
and Chest and my Land to be sold and the Money put in Bank
