Item 1st I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and
Christianlike manner suitable to my circumstances and condition in
life. As soon as I trust shall return to rest with God who gave it

Item 2nd It is my will and desire as I am now of debt that all my prop-
erty remain together as it is now and be controlled solely by my wife until
the youngest child arrives to full age of maturity for the benefit of her and
the children and on the arrival of the youngest child of full age it is my des-
ire that all the property both personal and real be equally divided between ^{my} wife
and children without bring in any of said property to sale. And further
it is my desire that in the event my wife should marry that no future husband
and she shall have or claim any control whatever over any of my property either
personal or real

Item 3rd It is my will and desire that my wife be appointed guardian for
each one of my children that is then under age

Item 4th I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife Charles execu-
trix of this my last will and testament this 15 day of December 1853

stances in life. My soul I trust shall remain to rest with God who gave
it.

(I declare second) I desire and direct that all my just debts (if any) be
paid as soon as possible.

(I declare third) I desire that all of my property (to wit) one tract of land
number one hundred and eighty four (184) in fifth (5) district and
part of section of original Cherokee land Chattooga County containing
one hundred & sixty (160) acres more or less together with all the
growing crops household & kitchen furniture stock of all kinds hives
cattle pigs & sheep be kept together for the use and benefit of my be-
loved wife Margaret Wright during her lifetime. After the death of my
wife to be disposed of in the manner hereinafter directed.

(I declare fourth) I give and devise to my beloved daughter Margaret Jane
Wright after the death of my wife one half of the above described tract of land
containing eighty (80) acres more or less with all the ^{rights member and} appurtenances to said parcel of
land in any way appurtenant and belonging forever together with all the
growing crops household and kitchen furniture stock of all kinds hives
cattle pigs & sheep to hold and properly to her own benefit & use the said (Margaret
Jane Wright).

(I declare fifth) I give and devise to my two grand children Jane W
Wright & Margaret A Wright equal after the death of my wife, the other
half of the above described tract of land eighty (80) acres more or less with
all the rights member and appurtenances to said parcel of land in any way
appurtenant and belonging to her own use & benefit forever this 28th March
1865
