Allgood, his executor, to give his guardian, and to Andrew Joseph Allgood, one hundred dollars in gold, and three hundred dollars in currency, and appoint my son, J. B. Allgood, his guardian. And if one of them should die without legal heirs, the other shall inherit his estate, the interest to be used for their education.

2^d. In my will that Rosanna, Kate, Woodrop, to have the hundred dollars in gold, and N^{ts} hundred dollars in silver.

3rd It is my Will that all the balance of my will estate
both real and personal be equally divided between my wife
Eliza, S. D. Algood, and my three children, Eliza Parks
Andrew D. Algood, and J. Burnett Algood, to have each
share alike, if my daughter Eliza should die before she
receives her share of my estate, then out of her proportion
share to be paid one fourth each, to her sons, Thomas Parks &
James Parks, and to be equally divided between her other three
children, George, & Mary, part, each to have one fourth, R. Walter D.
and Leda, to Parks, and in that event, I do appoint my son
S. D. Algood guardian for my three children, my daughter Eliza
who may be under age, and I do appoint Andrew D. Algood
and J. Burnett Algood, executors to this my last will
and testament, and to them to sell all my lands, & other
property with all I possess, or possess as they may
think best for the estate.

I'm sitting here at the said Veterans Hall good to this my
dear home now. I have lived here this 16th day of February 1944
in the hospital. I have lived here for several years and now,
I am at the H. H. Hall.
