viz Lot 1 & 200 Acre and Sixty four (24) in the 6th Dist and 4th Section of his County and I further bequeath a Sufficient amount of the rents of Lot 1 & 202 for her support during her life time.

Baker Guardian for my said Daughter, her heirs, Executors and to do as such for her, and control his wife for her benefit until she is lawfully married.
