Item I do I desire the remaining property to be kept together for the mutual benefit of my wife and child or children as the case may be

Item I do I now declare and appoint my wife Henrietta Frances Whimbart and A W Whimbart executors of this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have caused my hand and seal to be affixed this November 23 1852
