The use of my land and other property to be for the benefit of those of my children who may remain on the Land and not for those who do not remain on the Land. And after the expiration of the above mentioned term of twenty five (25) years I desire that my lot of Land and my other property that my estate may be possessed of to be sold by my executor and the proceeds of the same be equally divided between my Six (6) children hereinafter named (to wit) my Daughter Mary L Wright and Sarah J Wright, my Son John A Wright, my Son James P Wright, my Daughter Rachel B Wright and my Grand Son Thomas J Wright In said Son of my Daughter Martha A Wright (now deceased).
